- 3) According to Scripture, what are the priorities of the church? List them in the order of importance.
 - Matthew 28:19-20, Hebrews 10:25, Acts 1:14, 2:44-47, Romans 12:3-8, Psalm 95:6, John 4:24
- 4) Why is it so important for the believer to continue to study Gods Word?
 - Psalm 119:105, Hebrews 4:12, 2 Timothy 2:15, 4:2-4, I Timothy 1:10, 6:3-5
