



SMALL GROUP DISCUSSION QUESTIONS “LIVING FOR THE NEXT LIFE” OCTOBER 25, 2015

The writer of Psalm 91 was convinced that security for life was found in trusting in God, and he encouraged himself that he would be delivered from any attacks life would bring. He was confident that help from God’s protecting angels was available to him. Therefore, the theme of Psalm 91 is “security in this life.” He also talks about the coming judgment of the wicked.

Discussion: What are some of the ways we can worship God? Which do you feel is most important, and what form of worship do you enjoy the most?

- 1) What do you believe is Satan’s plan? Does he think he will win? What does he use to destroy people’s lives?
 - Mark 4:15, Luke 23:31, 2 Corinthians 11:14, Revelation 12:9, Acts 5:3
- 2) Taking Scripture out of context is a common problem. Can you give examples of individuals who do that? Which passages do they use? Are there biblical examples of Satan using this tactic?
 - Genesis 3, Psalm 91, Ephesians 5:22, Romans 13:8, Matthew 7:1
- 3) What are some of the things that should take place in a believers’ lives as they age in the faith?
 - Psalm 90:10, 93:12, Titus 2:2-3, Ecclesiastes 2:1-7, Job 12:12
- 4) How do you refocus your spiritual walk when life’s circumstances seem to overwhelm?
 - Psalm 94:18-19, John 14:1-6, 2 Corinthians 4:17, 2 Timothy 4:8
